The competition is open for Grade IX to Grade XII students from all over the world who have a passion for programming and an aptitude for problem-solving.

2. The IOI challenges students to apply their skills to solve complex algorithmic problems and to demonstrate their programming abilities in a competitive environment. Participation in the IOI contest is the best opportunity for students to showcase their talents and to receive international recognition for their hard work and achievements.

3. FBISE has been mandated by the Federal Government to execute and conduct national level Olympiad contest namely, Pakistan Olympiad in Informatics (POI) and prepare selected best students for participation in the International Olympiad in Informatics (IOI) 2024 by representing Pakistan.

4. You are requested to select top three students on the basis of inter directorate competition open to all the aspiring students. The selected students will be allowed to take part in the POI contest along with other students to be selected by other educational boards of Pakistan through IBCC.
